EXTRACT FROM CITY OF MELVILLE HEALTH LOCAL LAWS RELATING TO THE KEEPING OF POULTRY

Poultry

69. A keeper of poultry shall ensure that -

- (a) at all times, properly constructed enclosures are provided and maintained and all poultry kept on premises are kept within the confines of such enclosures;
- (b) adequate housing is provided for the poultry as approved by the Manager Health Services and such housing is maintained and kept clean at all times so as not to create offensive odours, or encourage fly breeding or the harbourage of vectors of disease. Such housing is to be located at least 1.2 metres from any property boundary and at least 9 metres from any place of human habitation;
- (c) no more than 12 poultry shall be kept on premises at any one time but, if an Environmental Health Officer deems a nuisance to exist, he/she may instruct that the poultry numbers be reduced or the poultry be removed from the premises altogether; and
- (d) an owner or occupier shall comply with a direction from an Environmental Health Officer under this Section.

Roosters, Geese, Peacocks and Turkeys

70. An owner or occupier of premises shall not -

- (a) without the written approval of the Manager Health Services; or
- (b) except in accordance with any conditions imposed by the Manager Health Services in connection with the approval under paragraph (a),

keep or permit to be kept, a rooster, goose, peacock, or turkey on the premises.
