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Further to the published Agenda for the Ordinary Meeting of Council to be held on 19 October 2010 the following Items have been included as an Addendum to the Agenda.

## **6. ELECTION OF DEPUTY MAYOR 2010/2011**

*Acknowledging that the provisions of the Local Government Act allow the person elected to occupy the position for a period of 24 months, Elected Members have indicated their desire to elect the Deputy Mayor for a period of only 12 months, candidates are asked to declare that they will stand down from the position and allow another ballot to be conducted in October 2011. This decision regarding the term of the Deputy Mayor can be amended by the majority of Elected Members.*

Cr Subramaniam has tendered his resignation in writing for the position of Deputy Mayor to take effect from 19 October 2010 when his 12 month tenure of Office concludes.

The Mayor will invite nominations for the Office of Deputy Mayor for the 2010/2011 period.

The Chief Executive Officer will assist the Mayor in conduct of the Election in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Act 1995.

Nominations must be received in writing preferably prior to the meeting and be provided to the Chief Executive Officer.

Nominations for Deputy Mayor close at the meeting at a time announced by the person conducting the election, which is to be a sufficient time after the announcement by that person that nominations are about to close to allow for any nominations made to be dealt with.

Following the conduct of the secret ballot, the Mayor will declare the position of Deputy Mayor expiring in October 2011.

### **DECLARATION**

The Chief Executive Officer will request the newly elected Deputy Mayor to make the **DECLARATION OF OFFICE**, in accordance with Section 2.29 of the Local Government Act 1995, which will be duly signed by the Deputy Mayor and the Mayor.
