



## Handy Hints for catching Public Transport

- 1) Not sure which bus or train to catch? Contact the **Transperth InfoLine** on **136213** for up-to-date information regarding timetables, planning a journey and general public transport queries.

Simply contact this number and provide the operator with your location and destination and they will be able to advise you on the best bus, rail or ferry connections for your trip.

- 2) Use the **Journey Planner** available on the Transperth website (<http://www.transperth.wa.gov.au>) to develop a personalised plan to get to your destination. Type in your starting point, destination and desired travel time and click on 'Plan Journey'.

These steps will provide you with a 'Journey Plan' on how to get to your destination including departure times of services and relevant stop numbers.

- 3) Register with **TravelEasy**, Transperth's free email update service which makes using your public transport system simpler and smarter. Registration is online at <http://www.transperth.wa.gov.au> and is fast and simple.

You can personalise your account to receive up to date public transport information, timetables and service changes delivered straight to your inbox.

With this service you can also select to receive updates on your mobile phone.

- 4) Make your own **Pocket Timetable**

If you have a mobile phone with a built in camera, it can be useful to take a photograph of the service timetable that may be displayed at your local bus stop.

This will provide a handy reminder of bus service times and will make it easier for you to walk to the bus stop just a few minutes before the bus arrives.

(Please note: More bus stop information modules will be installed in your area ready for the opening of the Mandurah Train Line.)
