**AIMS:** To protect and enhance the natural environment of the Bicton Foreshore from the Bicton Baths through to Point Walter by:

- a) cooperating with local bodies, the community and State Planning and Management Authorities to develop and monitor the Bicton Foreshore and Point Walter for the benefit of all users of the public open space and Reserves
- b) providing for the protection and accommodation of local fauna and bird life
- c) managing invasive flora and encourage appropriate species, selected to protect and enhance the area without restricting the unique river and associated views.
