



## A Young Person's Guide to Joining City of Melville Libraries

Any permanent resident of Western Australia can join the City of Melville library service for free. If you are under 18, a parent or guardian will need to authorise your library membership and accept responsibility for any library material borrowed using your library card.

### For those under 18

#### Step 1: Get a library membership form in any of these ways:

- Download it from the library website [www.melvillecity.com.au/libraries/membership](http://www.melvillecity.com.au/libraries/membership)
- Ask if your school has copies – some local schools distribute membership forms in Term One
- Collect a form from any of our five branches:

A.H. Bracks Library	Cnr Stock Road & Canning Highway, Melville
Bull Creek Library	24 Leichhardt Street, Bull Creek
Canning Bridge Library	2 Kintail Road, Applecross
Civic Square Library	10 Almondbury Road, Booragoon
Willagee Library	Cnr Archibald and Winnacott Streets, Willagee

#### Step 2: Ask your parent or guardian to complete the form.

Your parent or guardian will need to visit one of our libraries to submit the form, sign the membership register and collect your card. Our libraries are open at convenient hours (see below). Your parent or guardian will also need to show proof of their name and current address using a driver's licence, motor vehicle licence, utility account, rates notice, rental agreement, health care card or pension card.

#### Step 3: Congratulations!

You are now a library member and can borrow library materials from any branch, use library computers, login from home to access online resources such as Your Tutor, Encyclopaedia Britannica and much more.

### For those 18 years and older

You need to complete the library membership form yourself and visit any branch with one of the approved documents mentioned in Step 2, showing your name and current address.
