Dr Helena Kadmos is a short story writer and lecturer at Murdoch University.

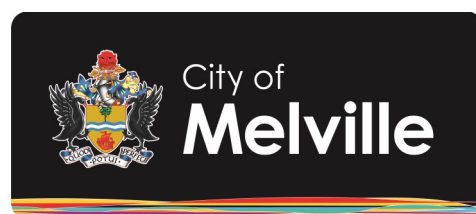


She has facilitated prize-winning collaborative creative writing projects with school students.
