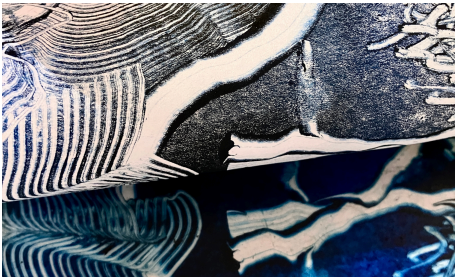


EXPRESSIVE LANDSCAPES - PLEIN AIR PAINTING with Bridget Seaton

EXPERIMENTAL PRINTMAKING with Bridget Seaton

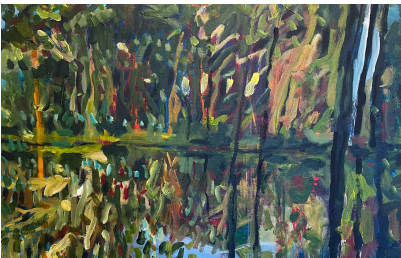
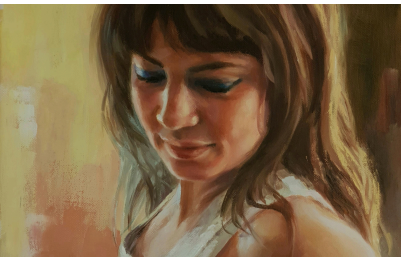
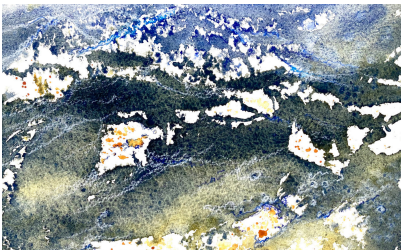
