FAMILY DAY CARE /IN HOME CARE SERVICE

Family Day Care is a home-based child care service that offers care and developmental activities by licensed individuals to families of young children.

Carers work from their own home, caring for a maximum of 7 children up to 12 years of age.

Groups of children may be different ages, allowing children in the same family to stay in care together.

The emphasis is on nurturing, learning and fun in a home environment.

Family Day Care offers flexible hours, daytime, evenings and weekends.

Care may be full time or part time and is particularly suitable for parents who have unusual work hours and require extended hours of child care for their children.

Family Day Care Schemes are operated by a sponsoring agency.

Fees are set and Child Care Benefit is available to those families who qualify according to income.

In Home Child Care Service

In Home Child Care aims to support the growing number of parents who are trying to balance work and family commitments. It provides personalised child care in the comfort and security of the child's own home.

In Home Care may be suitable where children are sick or recuperating from illness, where parents work outside normal business hours, where parents are ill or hospitalised, where children or parents have a disability.
