Terms and Conditions

a. Eligibility

The Harmony/Neighbour Day Drawing and Writing competition is open to residents of all ages from the City of Melville (see [boundary map and list of suburbs](#)). Proof of residency may be requested from the winning entrant. City of Melville staff or Elected Members and their spouse/partner, parents, children and grandchildren are ineligible to enter.

The City reserves the right to disqualify any entry that is not in accordance with these terms and conditions or who has, in the opinion of the City, engaged in conduct in entering the draw which is fraudulent, misleading, and deceptive or generally damaging to the goodwill or reputation of the City and spirit of the campaign. The City reserves the right to disqualify a winner without warning or notice if the City becomes aware that the winner and/or the winner's entry is of a type described in this clause. The City accepts no responsibility for any late or misdirected registrations due to technical disruptions, network congestion or for any other reason.

b. Entry

Entry to the competition requires submitting a drawing or literacy piece about a personal experience or thoughts which reflect friendly neighbours to the City of Melville Civic Centre, Community Centres or a City of Melville library branch with a name and contact option (phone or email) of a parent or guardian. The drawing can be done on page 19 of the March 2021 Mosaic magazine or another blank sheet of paper.

Entry into the prize draw is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions. The competition runs from 12.00am Thursday, 18 March and closes 5.00pm on Friday, 11 July 2021.

c. Prize Draw Queries

d. Prizes

Prizes include three (3) vouchers for family activities valued at \$75 and 3 kids' gift packs. The final number of prizes will be decided by the City. Winners will be randomly drawn throughout the week at the City's discretion, but will likely occur on July 13, 2021.

e. Prize Draw

The winning entrants shall each receive either a voucher prize or kids pack. The prize will be

decided upon through communication with the winning entrant. No choice of prize is given if either or both prize options have run out.

f. Notification of Winners

Winners will be notified via their chosen contact method when submitting their piece to make arrangements for prize collection. A photo of the winner may be requested by the City for promotional use. The City reserves the right to select an alternative winner should they be unable to contact a winning entrant.

If the prize is unclaimed or un-awarded after 7 days, the prize will be forfeited and may be used by the City for an alternative purpose, entirely at the discretion of the City.

g. Legal Conditions

In the case of the intervention of any outside act, agent or event which prevents or significantly hinders the City's ability to proceed with this promotion and in the manner described in these terms and conditions, including but not limited to vandalism, computer virus, technical failure, acts of God, the City may in its absolute discretion cancel the promotion and/or recommence it from the start on the same conditions.

The City is not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information, either caused by the entrant or for any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilised in this campaign, or for any technical error, or any combination thereof that may occur in the course of the administration of this campaign including any omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line or satellite network failure, theft or destruction or unauthorised access to or alteration of entries.

All information is handled in accordance with City's Privacy Policy, and the City will not use the information the entrant provides for anything other than for the purposes of administering the competition.
