FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Why are we introducing new Flippa levels to LeisureFit Booragoon?

Over the coming months Flippa Swim School will be making improvements to our program to help our swimmers progress more easily, as well as simplifying our program for parents.

Aquababes → Flippa levels 1 – 12 → Youth Swim / Teen Swim

Aquababes, Special Needs and Adult classes will not be affected.

Are these new Flippa levels the same as the Education Department or other Swim Schools?

The new program has been specifically designed for the Flippa Swim School with the progress of our swimmers in mind. It is not the same as any other swim school. Therefore, if your swimmer is new to the Flippa Swim School please book in for a free swim assessment at our reception desk calling the Centre on 9364 0823 or booking online at www.melvillecity.com.au/swimschool

When will these new Flippa levels begin?

Our new levels will take effect from our January XLR8 program and Term 1 2019.

What do I need to do as parent to prepare for these new Flippa levels?

You will just need to enrol into classes as you usually would for any other term or XRL8 program. Your swimmer's level for the coming term will be indicated on their enrolment form.

How does this affect my swimmer's enrolment for next term?

You may see a difference in your swimmer's "Level" number on their enrolment form, but the skills will be very similar to those your swimmer is currently undertaking, if not the same. Therefore, your swimmer will not be disadvantaged in anyway under the new levels.

How do I know what level my swimmer will be?

The new Flippa level will be on your swimmer's enrolment form along with their certificate, which they will receive during their Week 9 lesson.

Once my child has completed the Aquababes program at 36 months, which level will they move into?

The first level of our program at the completion of Aquababes is Flippa 1.

What level does my swimmer need to be to enrol into Carnival Coaching in the January XLR8 program?

Swimmers must have achieved Level 6 Beginner of our current program or a Flippa 9 of our new Flippa program.

What if I am new to Flippa Swim School or returning to the program after a term off?
