

Native Frogs of Piney Lakes Reserve



Squelching Froglet: *Crinia insignifera*

About the size of a 5c piece; has brown stripes



Clicking Froglet: *Crinia glauerti*

Smaller than a 5c piece; is dark in colour



Quacking Frog: *Crinia georgiana*

Smaller than a 5c piece; is light brownish and has small red patch in the groin



Western Banjo or Pobblebonk Frog:

Limnodynastes dorsalis

Large and stout, can grow up to 7.5cm; grey or dark green in colour with splotches



Moaning Frog: *Heleioporus eyrei*

Stout, light brown with mottled grey and yellow patches, can grow up to 6.5cm



Motorbike Frog: *Litoria moorei*

Can grow quite large, up to 8cm in length, can have blue or green spots, can vary from bright green in colour to a deep murky brown



Slender Tree Frog: *Litoria adelaidensis*

Long and slender – can grow up to 7cm. Can be murky brown to bright green in colour (will be living amongst the long reeds)
