

Pay your Rates Early and Paperless Rates Prize Draws Terms and Conditions

This competition is being held and promoted by the City of Melville. Participation in the Pay Your Rates Early Prize Draw and Paperless Rates Prize Draw constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

Pay Your Rates Early Prize Draw

- The competition is open to ratepayers of the City of Melville who pay the full amount due as listed on their 2018/19 rates notice before 5.00pm (WST) Tuesday, 14 August 2018.
- Payment must be received before the closing date above to go into the draw.
- Elected Members, closely associated persons and staff of the City of Melville are ineligible to enter the draw and win prizes as a sole or part owner of any property.
- Prizes can be won by residential ratepayers only.
- Prize winners will be drawn at the City of Melville Civic Centre, in the week commencing Monday, 3 September 2018 and winners will be notified by phone and/or email
- The eight prize winners will be chosen at random from a database of all eligible rate payments received. The City's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- The eight prize winners will be invited to attend a prize presentation the week commencing 9 September 2018 to collect their prize. If a prize winner is unable to attend the prize presentation, the City will arrange for the prize winner to pick up their prize from the City of Melville Civic Centre following the prize presentation. Prizes will not be mailed or delivered to prize winners.
- Prize winners must present a current form of identification to receive/collect their prize. If a prize winner wants to send a representative to collect their prize, the representative must bring with them authorisation in writing from the prize winner.
- The prizes are not transferable, exchangeable or redeemable for cash. Prizes which are lost, stolen or misplaced will not be replaced or reissued. Prizes must be collected by the prize winner by Monday, 7 January 2019 or they will be judged as forfeited.

- Registration must be completed by the closing date above to go into the draw.
- Elected Members, closely associated persons and staff of the City of Melville are ineligible to enter the draw and win prizes as a sole or part owner of any property.
- Prizes can be won by residential ratepayers only.
- Prize winners will be drawn at the City of Melville Civic Centre, in the week commencing Monday, 3 September 2018 and winners will be notified by phone and/or email
- The twelve winners will be chosen at random from a database of all ratepayers signed up for eNotices or ByPay View. The City's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- The twelve winners will be invited to attend a prize presentation the week commencing 9 September 2018 to collect their prize. If a winner is unable to attend the prize presentation, the City will arrange for the winner to pick up their prize from the City of Melville Civic Centre following the prize presentation. Prizes will not be mailed or delivered to prize winners.
