

## **Youth Sport Grant**

Supporting local young athletes selected to represent Western Australia or Australia in their chosen sport.

## To be eligible, the applicant must:

- 1. be 18 years or younger (inclusive) at the time of event.
- 2. be a resident of the City of Melville, with proof of address provided.
- 3. have been selected by a State or National Sporting Association to represent Western Australia or Australia.

As a guide, <u>Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries</u> and <u>Australian Sports</u>
<u>Commission</u> websites provide a list of these Sporting Associations.

- 4. demonstrate the selection process they were required to undertake to gain selection.
- 5. provide written proof of selection, which must include:
  - a. applicant's full name,
  - b. confirmation of selection, and level of representation (state, national or international)
  - c. event details (event name, age bracket, location and dates), and
  - d. endorsement by the nominated State or National Sporting Association.
- 6. be seeking funding to support travel costs, entry fees or other event-related expenses associated with attending the competition. Funding cannot be used for personal gain.
- 7. submit the application form prior to the start date of the nominated sporting event. Retrospective applications will not be accepted.
- 8. not have received the Youth Sport Grant within the past two years from the date of a successful submission.

## **Guidelines**

- The applicant must meet all eligibility criteria at time of application and remain eligible throughout the entire process. Any changes affecting eligibility must be reported to the City of Melville.
- Application outcomes are at the sole discretion of the City of Melville. Decisions are final and not subject to appeal.
- The Youth Sport Grant may be oversubscribed and is not guaranteed. Successful applications are subject to funding availability.
- If successful, applicants will receive a one-off payment of \$200. The City reserves the right to
  withhold payment until the final cutoff for event registrations and confirmation that the event
  will proceed.
- Receipt of payment is not guaranteed prior to the commencement of the nominated sporting event.
