

Residential/Visitors Parking Permit Guide (to be used as a guideline only)

The City of Melville provides parking permits to residents in accordance with the Parking Permit Policy and Parking Local Law.

RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMITS – Freehold, Strata or Survey Strata Properties

Residential Parking Permit(s) will only be issued to the occupier of the above, in accordance with the following:-

Where no off-street parking for vehicles is available, a maximum of **two** Residential Parking Permits may be issued.

Where parking for **one** vehicle only can be provided off-street, a maximum **one** Residential Parking Permit may be issued.

Where parking for **two** or more vehicles can be provided off-street, **no** Residential Parking Permits will be issued

*Apartment Developments are not eligible for Residential Parking Permits.

VISITORS' PARKING PERMITS

Where no parking can be provided on the land beyond that required for the resident and no unrestricted parking within 200m of the property;

A maximum of two Visitors Parking Permits shall only be issued to the occupier of a freehold, Strata or Survey Strata Property and a maximum of one Visitor Parking Permit shall only be issued to Apartment Developments, as required.
