City of Melville Kearns Crescent Streetscape Upgrade ENGAGEMENT SNAPSHOT

To understand how Kearns Crescent streetscape could better meet current and future community needs, we asked the community to share their values and vision for the area to help inform the development of concept designs.

This first stage of engagement encouraged the community to get involved via an interactive map and survey between 27 October and 17 November 2022. The feedback will help inform the development of concept design options in 2023.

Future engagement opportunities will then capture community feedback on the proposed concepts to support the City's decision-making about the preferred concept.
