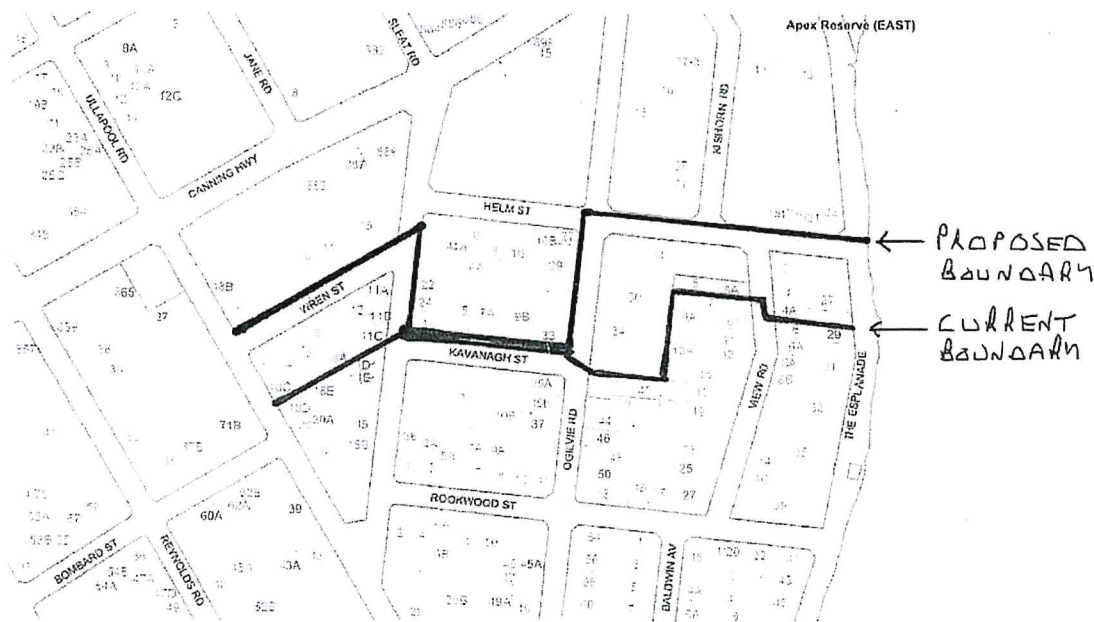


13.2 Petition – To Change South-Eastern Boundary of the Canning Bridge Activity Centre Plan.

A petition signed by 191 residents of the City of Melville has been received and reads as follows:

"We the undersigned, all being electors of the City of Melville respectfully request that the Council:

Action Sought: Move the south-eastern boundary of the Canning Bridge Activity Centre Plan ("CBACP") so it follows the road carriageway of Helm Street, Oglivie Road, Kavanagh Street, Sleat Road and Wren Street (as shown on the attached plan in blue).



The Reasons Supporting this action:

The current boundary of the CBACP in this area is located on the fence line between adjoining properties, resulting in direct conflicts between the rules that apply within and outside of the CBACP. These conflicts were not considered and addressed when the CBACP was prepared. It is common sense and good planning to have the boundaries for zone changes located along the street frontage of properties so ensuring that the street or road creates a buffer between zones."

OFFICER RECOMMENDATION

At 8:18pm Cr Kepert moved, seconded Cr Mair –

That the petition in requesting to move the south-eastern boundary of the Canning Bridge Activity Centre Plan ("CBACP") so it follows the road carriageway of Helm Street, Oglivie Road, Kavanagh Street, Sleat Road and Wren Street, signed by 191 residents be acknowledged and a report be prepared.
