This Advice Note has been prepared in response to a Notice of Motion relating to 13 The Esplanade and 64 Kishorn Road, that will be considered by Council at the 15 March 2022 Ordinary Meeting of Council.

The Motion that will be considered is:

That the Council directs the CEO to prepare a report to be presented to the May 2022 Ordinary Meeting of Council on restoring the former Mt Pleasant Senior Citizens site at 13 The Esplanade/ 64 Kishorn Rd, Mt Pleasant to community use as public open green space with tree plantings.

This Motion should be considered in conjunction with a resolution from the General Meeting of Electors Item (M22/5895 Motion 3) that the Council consider rezoning and retaining the City land holdings in Moreau Mews and Kishorn Road as public open space. Both items should be considered together as they relate to public open space in the CBACP area. Officers are recommending that a decision on Moreau Mews and Kishorn Road be deferred until the public open space needs of the Canning Bridge Precinct has been assessed and determined.
