



**E25/65 RFT242521 Remediation & Reconstruction
Services of Majestic Boardwalk**

Majestic Close Boardwalk Tender(s)

- The City went to Tender in August 2024 for the remediation and reconstruction of the Majestic Boardwalk, Applecross (RFT242505).
- One submission was received. The submission was higher than the budget allocated, with further staff concerns over the tenderer's capacity to deliver the works, based on expertise and experience.
- On 22 October 2024 CTAU approved the Evaluation Panel's recommendation to decline all offers submitted for RFT242505, based on the submission received and the budget allocated.
- CTAU recommendation was to go back to market, via an new Request for Tender.
- It was agreed that this process should happen as soon as possible as potential suppliers had indicted the reason for not participating in the RFT242505, was due to the quick turnaround between the Tender process and the construction period.



RFT242521

- As per the CTAU recommendation the City went back to market with RFT 242521, in early 2025.
- Four competitive Tenders were received:
 - D.B. Cunninghams Pty Ltd T/AS Advantearing - Civil Engineers
 - Fortec Australia Pty Ltd
 - Fulton Hogan Industries Pty Ltd
 - Infillr Pty Ltd T/AS Haul Group
- The recommended supplier achieved a qualitative score of 90% against the City's criteria.





Why now?

- Based on the structural report received, it is in the City's best interest to progress the remediation and reconstruction of the Majestic Boardwalk, as soon as possible.
- The project is reliant on seasonal elements and must be completed in the summer months, when the tide is at its lowest.



City Recommendation

- CTAU recommended Tenderer was the most competitive cost and provided the best methodology for the works.
- Recommended Tenderer has completed works previously on the majestic boardwalk and other projects in the City.
- Works are expected to take six months with the majority of works to commence in the latter part of 2025 (October / November 2025).
