BUSH FIRES (FIREBREAKS) REPEAL LOCAL LAW 2021

Under the powers conferred by the *Bush Fires Act 1954*, *Local Government Act 1995*, and all other powers enabling it, the Council of the City of Melville resolved on 16 March 2021 to make the following local law:

1. Citation

This local law may be cited as the *City of Melville Bush Fires (Firebreaks) Repeal Local Law 2021*.

2. Commencement

This local law comes into operation 14 days after its publication in the *Government Gazette*.

3. Local Law Relating to Firebreaks 1997 repealed

The *City of Melville Local Law Relating to Firebreaks 1997* published in the *Government Gazette* on 1 July 1997, as amended in the *Government Gazette* on 22 April 2005 and 24 June 2005, is repealed.
