DETAIL

A minor change to CP-110 – Crossover Policy has been made following feedback from a resident which was copied to an Elected Member. This change is to:

- a) improve the consistency between the policy and the Crossover Guidelines and Specifications by removing duplication and improving consistency; and
- b) make a minor change to wording to improve clarity and readability.

Specifically the second paragraph in the Policy Statement has been removed as it only refers to the width of residential and not commercial crossovers. Both types of crossover are fully specified in the Crossover Guidelines and Specifications which is referred to in the policy.

The third paragraph has been modified to match the wording in the Crossover Guidelines and Specifications.

All crossovers shall be constructed to the City's Crossover Guidelines and Specifications. Crossover construction, renewal and maintenance shall be in accordance with the City's Crossover Guidelines and Specifications where practical. Where it is not practical, the City may approve a non-standard crossover. Where this occurs, the City shall document its reasons.
