

Rates Prize Draw 2026 – 2027 Terms and Conditions

This competition is being held and promoted by the City of Melville. Participation in the 2026 – 2027 Rates Prize Draw constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

Rates Prize Draw

- The competition is open to commercial and residential ratepayers of the City of Melville who pay their rates in full or their first instalment by the first instalment due date Friday, 28 August 2026 using any payment method.
- Three winners will be awarded a prize of \$1,000 donated by Westpac, plus a 12-month LeisureFit Healthy Life PLUS Membership.
- The prizes will be drawn the week after the first instalment due date (Friday, 28 August 2026).
- Prize winners will be notified and requested to open a Westpac account if they do not already hold one.
- Prize winners contact details and full names will be confirmed and provided to Westpac Senior Relationship Manager.
- Prize winners will be provided a letter from the Westpac Senior Relationship Manager to take to their nearest branch.
- The Branch will contact the Westpac Senior Relationship Manager to authorise over the phone and transfer the funds (three prizes of \$1,000).
- Elected Members, closely associated persons* and staff of the City of Melville are ineligible to enter the draw and win prizes as a sole or part owner of any property.
- Prize winners will be drawn at the City of Melville Civic Centre, and winners will be notified by phone and/or email within two business days of the draw. The City's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- If a prize is unclaimed or un-awarded after 15 business days, a second and final prize draw will be conducted. They will also be notified by email/phone within two business days of the draw. If the prize remains unclaimed after 15 business days, the prize will be forfeited and may be used by the City for an alternative purpose, entirely at the discretion of the City.
- The prize winners will be chosen at random from a database of all eligible rate payments received. The City's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- By accepting the prize, prize winners consent to their name being used to promote their win of the prize without the approval of the prize winner. Prize winners will be listed on the City's website.
