That the Council resolves to request the CEO to:

- 1) Assist the Applecross Tennis Club to prepare and submit an application to the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions (DBCA) for approval to install LED lighting to facilitate night usage of the tennis courts at the Applecross Tennis Club at 32 The Strand, Applecross.**
- 2) Review the design for the installation of lighting in consultation with the Applecross Tennis Club, to ensure compliance with Australian Standard 4282:2019 - control of the obtrusive effects of lighting and the principles WAPC's Position Statement: Dark sky and astrotourism (2022).**
- 3) Release to the Applecross Tennis Club the legal advice obtained by the City regarding the current order of the Supreme Court of Western Australia in relation to the installation of lighting at the Applecross Tennis Club.**
- 4) Advise the Council as to the progress of any application by the Applecross Tennis Club for the installation of lighting.**

Reasons

1. The Tennis Strategy Report 2021 commissioned by the City of Melville has confirmed that there is strong demand for after hours usage of the tennis courts at the Applecross Tennis Club;
2. Management of the installation project by the City should allow a 'best practice' light installation which can be replicated in future projects.
