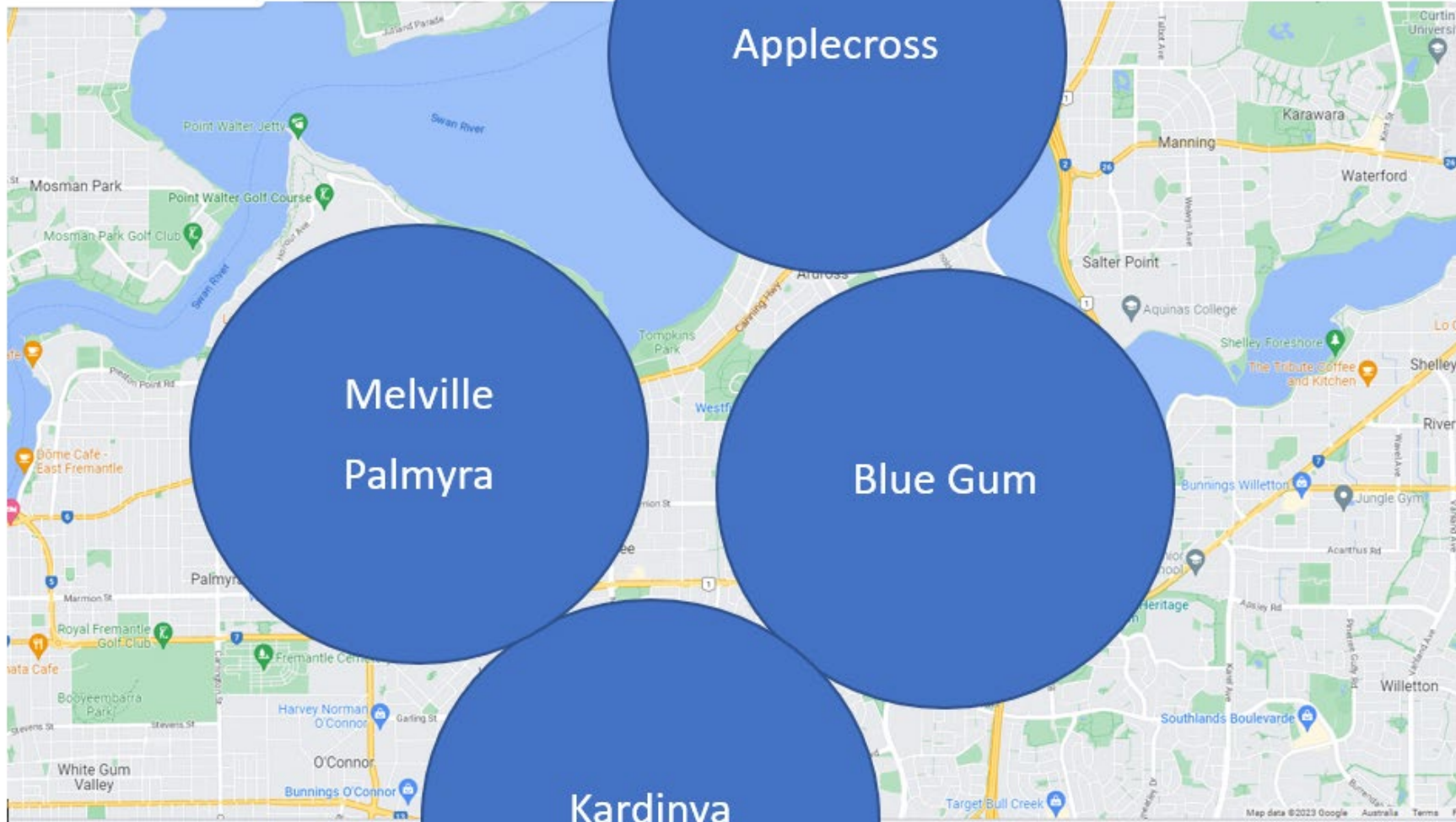

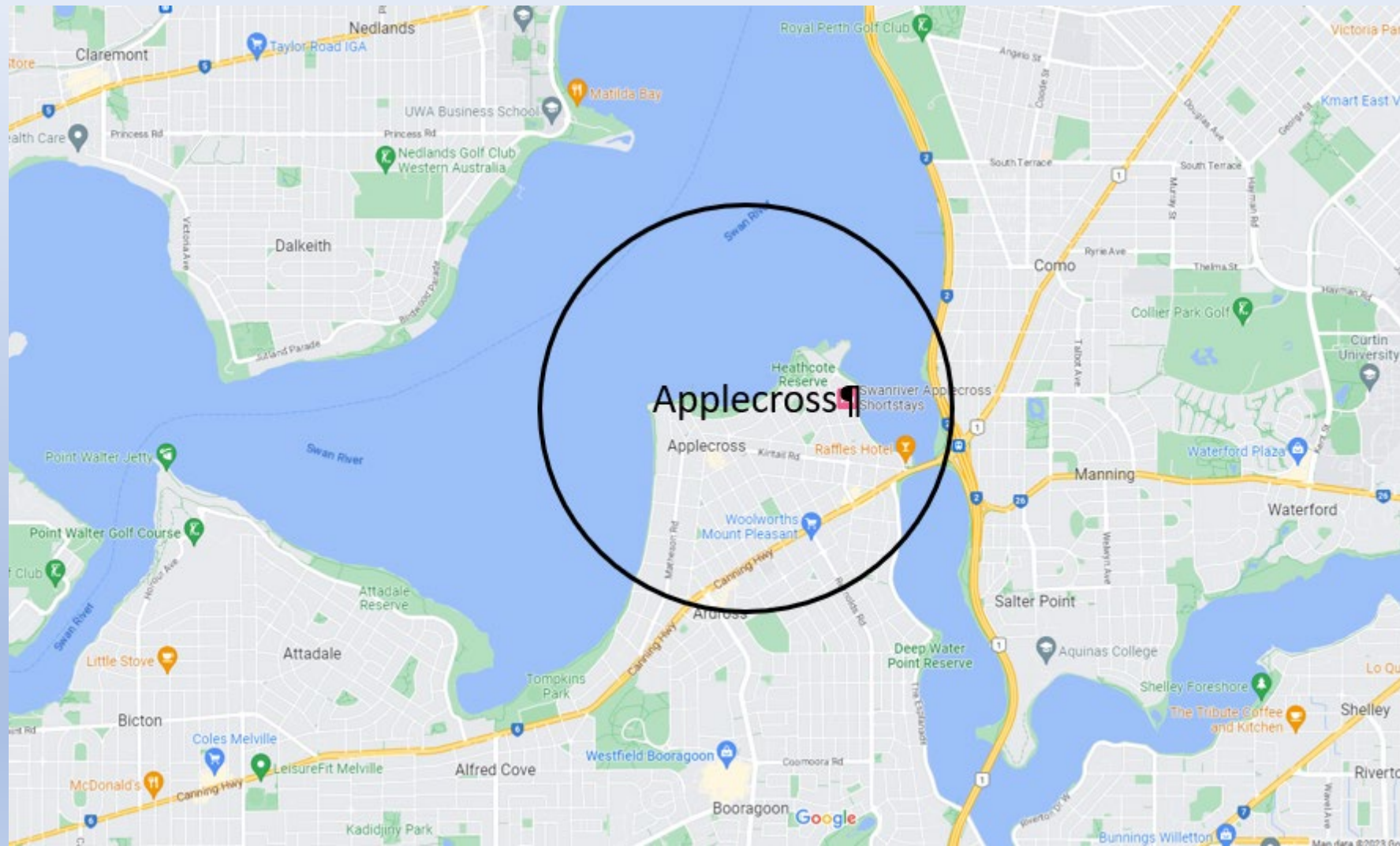

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Noise

- **2019 conclusion of Club's consultants not relevant in 2023**
- **No noise assessment by Club or City**
- **Resident organised report confirmed noise is likely to exceed prescribed standards**
- **Why is there no mention of this report, its conclusions and potential ramifications in the DAU?**
- **Noise from doors slamming and the long and loud good nights, see you later!**

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DAU Conclusions

Concerns raised by objectors, not adequately addressed in DAU – just dismissed

Compliance with 9.00pm lights out but noise and lighting requirements ignored

DAU stated a condition of lights off by 9.00pm – No bar usage – vacate premises by 9.15pm

Happy for Club to be there no lights

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Conclusions

- **No demonstrable demand or need for the additional lighted courts in the City**
- **Light towers will be a blot on the landscape during the day**
- **Illumination impact will be significant at night – contrary to amenity impact issues in lighting standard**
- **Noise levels likely to exceed the prescribed standards of the Environmental Protection (Noise) Regulations 1997**
- **Residents happy for there to be a Club – just no change of use**
- **We need to respect each other and co-exist without unnecessary, intrusive lighting and noise in a residential area**
- **Council should not support**

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
