DETAIL

The Council will be considering a petition at the 17 May 2022 Ordinary Meeting of Council regarding a request from Attadale Junior Football Club for temporary car parking at Troy Park in an area previously used but now known to provide breeding habitat for the Rainbow Bee Eater. The City had previously not approved temporary overflow parking in this area due to environmental sensitivities and identified an alternative overflow parking area at the eastern end of the Attadale Reserve dog exercise area. The officers recommendation regarding the request being the subject of the petition is to retain the Attadale Reserve overflow parking area rather than reinstate the area requested by the club.

Following the publishing of the agenda for the 17 May 2022 Ordinary Meeting of Council, the City received an updated proposal from the Attadale Junior Football Club seeking consideration for permission to utilise two alternative areas:

- An area behind the goals but within the oval buffer at the western end of the Troy Park oval. This area is identified as Option 1 below; and
- Another area (Option 2) located to the east of the grove of trees at Point Waylen. The proposal suggests that both overflow parking areas would be accessed by a cordoned off track from the main car park shown in green outside the southern and eastern boundary of the oval.





With both the options, marshalling of the vehicles for the temporary overflow parking area would be the responsibility of the club, noting if someone was to be injured by a vehicle during the approved marshalling activity plan there may be the possibility the City could be held responsible.



Based on the information above following assessment of the proposals, Officers do not support either option and maintain the officer recommendation contained in report to the Council that the club use the approved overflow parking area in the eastern section of the Attadale Reserve dog exercise area, depicted in blue on the imaged above, so as not to disturb the Rainbow Bee-eater nesting sites in the area shown in red.

OFFICER RECOMMENDATION (3979)

That the Council:

- 1. Does not support the overflow parking area identified by the Attadale Junior Football Club for the reasons outlined in this report**
- 2. Directs the CEO to advise the Attadale Junior Football Club that the current overflow parking designated area within the Attadale Foreshore dog walking area is available for use during high use periods.**
- 3. Directs the CEO to advise the lead petitioner in writing of this outcome.**
