MelSafe is the City of Melville's community safety service. We are here to help. Our friendly officers patrol the streets to help keep everyone safe. If you feel unsafe, here's who you can call.



### MelSafe

Call 131 247 if:

- You see something that doesn't feel right (like someone acting suspicious).
- There's a lot of noise or trouble nearby and you need help.
- A dog or cat is lost, wandering, or acting aggressive.
- A car is parked unsafely, like on a footpath.



### Police

Call 000 for an emergency like a fire, a crash on the road, or if someone is hurt.

Call 131 444 for Police assistance or to report something. Police and MelSafe work closely together to keep everyone safe.
