1	██████████	Kardinya	Windelya Road	I am in favour of renaming the whole (not just a portion) of Farrington Street as Windelya Road. I have to declare an interest in the name, since it was recommended by my father, Russell George, when he was a senior officer in the then-Department of Lands and Surveys. It's an indigenous word meaning 'bush track' which described it aptly when we moved here in 1955. My father also proposed the name Kardinya (meaning 'sunrise') when the area became a postal district. It was formally gazetted on 16 June 1961. Although Maritime Avenue has an historical association with the district (being named after a kind of pine tree grown in the Somerville Pine Plantation), Windelya has a stronger association with the land and is a more appropriate name.
