- A petition signed by 250 residents of the City of Melville, was received on 24 September 2020. Additional signatures from 80 residents and 7 non-residents was received 19 October 2020.
- The petition, totalling 330 signatures requested Council to reconsider the decision to construct an amenities building at Bert Jeffery Park and to move the Applecross Cricket Club to the Shirley Strickland Reserve.
- At the 20 October 2020 Ordinary Meeting of Council, Council resolved that the petition be acknowledged and a report be prepared and presented to the November 2020 Ordinary Meeting of Council.

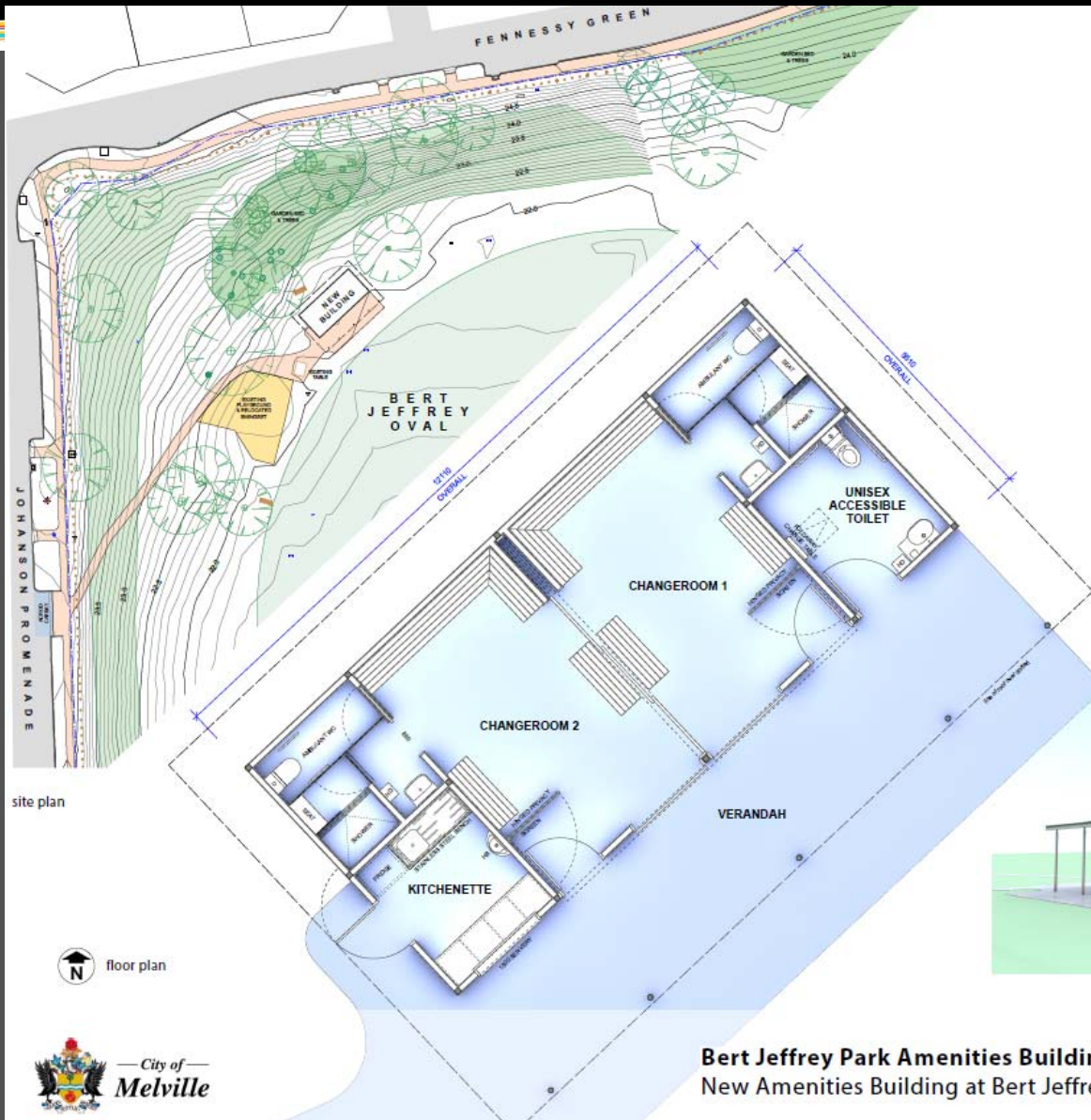
## CD20\_8138 Bert Jeffrey Park Petition – Reconsider Construction

- Drink fountain with dog water bowl at the base utilising the services brought to the area through the development of the amenity building.
