# **Officer Presentation**

**C24/128 – Melville City Centre Bushfire Management**

Ms D Whyte, Acting Director Corporate Services

- A portion of the City's Civic Centre site has vegetation that triggers a classification of the site as containing bushfire prone vegetation, increasing the bushfire attack level (BAL) for the Library and Cultural Centre (LCC), future land swap site and adjoining development sites.
- Vegetation management of the affected area to a low threat vegetation status will reduce the bushfire attack level (BAL), whilst still retaining the conservation value trees.
- Vegetation management will provide multiple benefits to the City and all the adjoining sites as it will facilitate the vision for the Booragoon (Melville) City Centre Structure Plan; and enable creation of the high street for placemaking activation.

# Elected Member Communication Agreement

- Will be a Mandatory Requirement under Local Government Reform
  - State Government Agreements – Minister and Assisting Agency
  - Standardised expectations
- Identified as a Priority Project during the development of the Governance Framework
  - Open and Respectful communication
  - Interim measure
- Structure and Process – clear separation of roles
  - Information and Advice
  - Timeframe

# City of Melville Parking Local Law 2023 - Undertaking

- New Parking Local Law adopted 12 December 2023 and came into effect 2 January 2024.
- Review of Joint Standing Committee on Delegated Legislation
- Request for minor changes when Local Law next reviewed
  - Definition “ disability parking permit”
  - Include a semi colon
  - Separate an existing clause into two separate clauses
  - Renumber a clause
- Once endorsed the City will provide an undertaking that these changes will be included in the next review.

# Proposed City of Melville Cat Local Law 2024

- City of Melville current does not have a Cat Local Law
- In 2021 Council resolved to produce the 2022 – 2026 Cat Management Strategy
  - adopted in March 2022
  - Include investigation and introduction of a Cat Local Law.
- Proposed Local Law based on WALGA Model Local Law
  - Purpose – promote responsible cat ownership and coordinated approach to the management of cats within the City of Melville.
  - Effect – to establish provisions to reduce the impact of domestic cats in the community.
  - Definition and reference to “foreshore area”
  - Definition of “nuisance”
  - Schedule 2 Cat Prohibition Areas
- Seeking Council endorsed to commence the process to make a local law with a minimum six-week community consultation process.

**CD24/14 – Parking Availability in Vicinity of 13 The Esplanade and 64 Kishorn Road Proposed  
POS, Mount Pleasant**

- Created to further clarify parking availability relevant to Council item E24/29 Public Open Space – The Esplanade
- Map of surveyed area bounded by Canning Highway, The Esplanade, Sleet Road and Rookwood Street, Mount Pleasant:
  - represents 400m proximity from 13 The Esplanade south of Canning Highway
  - includes four off street parking areas and designated street parking bays
- A total of 217 designated and publicly accessible parking bays exist within the area:
  - inclusive of 4 ACROD bays
  - five currently not available due to construction purposes
- Additional street parking along The Esplanade south of Helm St (three-hour restrictions apply); on street parking on View Road, Kavanagh St, Ogilive Rd (two-hour restrictions apply)
