

13.1 Petition – Seeking to move the South-Eastern Boundary of the Canning Bridge Activity Centre Plan to Helm Street

A petition signed by 52 residents of the City of Melville has been received and reads as follows:

“We the undersigned, all being electors of the City of Melville respectfully request that the Council:

- 1) *It is noted that while the full review of the Canning Bridge Activity Center Plan (BACP) is progressed, the Council may proceed in parallel to approve Local Planning Policies and to amend the existing CBACP to expeditiously correct serious issues with the existing CBACP.*
- 2) *One such serious issue is the inequitable anomaly created by the locating the (sic) south eastern CBACP H4 boundary along adjacent residential boundaries, rather than streets, causing direct conflicts between the planning rules and protections applying within and outside the CBACP.*
- 3) *Out of fairness to existing residents and potential developers, we call for this issue to be urgently rectified by moving the south eastern CBACP H4 boundary to Helm Street where there is a buffer between zones as a consequence of the Street space between the two.”*

OFFICER RECOMMENDATION

That the petition in requesting the relocation of the South-Eastern Boundary of the Canning Bridge Activity Centre Plan to Helm Street, signed by 52 residents be acknowledged and a report be prepared.
