
PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED NAMING OF NEW ROADS BY THE CITY OF MELVILLE

The City of Melville gives notice of its intention to officially name two new roads to be created as a result of subdivision of the former Carawatha Primary School site being Lot 300 (10) Archibald Street, Willagee.

**Proposed names:**

- Sumpton Loop** – William J Sumpton operated the first bus service in Melville (1924) in the Palmyra/ Melville / Willagee Ward.
- Utting Lane** – Phillip Utting was the first Headmaster of Carawatha Primary School 1959-1972.

The proposed road names have been selected from the Council's adopted Schedule of Names, to meet the naming requirements of Council Policy No. CP- 096, and Landgate's Geographical Names Committee Policies and Standards.
