HEALTH (EATING-HOUSES) REPEAL LOCAL LAW 2021

Under the powers conferred by the *Health (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1911, Local Government Act 1995*, and all other powers enabling it, the Council of the City of Melville resolved on 16 March 2021 to make the following local law:

1. Citation

This local law may be cited as the *City of Melville Health (Eating-Houses) Repeal Local Law 2021*.

2. Commencement

This local law comes into operation on the day it is published in the *Government Gazette*.

3. Health (Eating-Houses) Local Laws 2001 repealed

The *City of Melville Health (Eating-Houses) Local Laws 2001* published in the *Government Gazette* on 21 December 2001 are repealed.
