



Youth Sport Grant

Supporting local young athletes selected to represent Western Australia or Australia in their chosen sport.

To apply, you must meet all the following:

- you are 18 years old or younger at the time of event
- you live in the City of Melville
- you have been selected to represent Western Australia or Australia
- you can explain how you were selected
- you can provide proof of selection from a State or National Sporting Association, which must include:

- your full name,
- confirmation of selection, and level of representation (state, national or international)
- event details (event name, age group, location and dates)
- confirmation that it has been issued or endorsed by the relevant State or National Sporting Association

Note: As a guide, Australian Sports Commission website provide a list of these Sporting Associations

- you will use the grant for travel costs, entry fees or other competition-related expenses
- submit the application before the event starts. Late applications will not be accepted.
- you have not have received a Youth Sport Grant in the past two years

Guidelines

- Applicants must meet all eligibility criteria at the time of application and remain eligible throughout the entire process. Any changes affecting eligibility must be reported to the City of Melville.
- To apply, applicants aged 18 years must submit an online application form. For applicants under the age of 18, the application must be submitted by a parent or legal guardian.
- All required information must be provided before the event start date.
- Applications must be submitted and received by the City, together with all required supporting information, prior to the commencement of the nominated event. Late, incomplete, or retrospective applications, including those submitted on or after the event start date, will not be accepted and will be deemed ineligible. Where sufficient time remains before the event commences, applicants may submit a new application.
- Application outcomes are at the sole discretion of the City of Melville. Decisions are final and not subject to appeal.
- The Youth Sport Grant is subject to available funding and is not guaranteed.
- Applications will be accepted until available funding is exhausted or the program closes. The City may close the program at any time.
- The grant is only for athletes representing Western Australia or Australia. Competitions representing a club or local team, including club championships, are not eligible.
- If successful, applicants will receive a one-off payment of \$200. The grant must be used for approved competition-related expenses and cannot be used for personal gain.
- Successful applicants will receive payment following approval. The City does not guarantee payment before the event date.
- The City reserves the right to withhold payment until event details are confirmed. Receipt of payment is not guaranteed prior to the commencement of the nominated sporting event.
- The City may refuse, withdraw, or recover funding where false, misleading, or incomplete information has been provided.
- No acquittal is required. However, the City reserves the right to request evidence that the applicant attended the approved event and used the funding for its intended purpose.



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
