Previous work in Natural Resource Management In 2013, the South West Group developed a Regional Natural Resource Management (NRM) Strategy – that document sets out a vision for the landscapes and natural areas of the South West Metropolitan Region that contains diverse and valued natural areas. It establishes an ‘NRM Framework’ for the six Councils to work together and with the Federal and State Governments, linking into their strategic and planning initiatives that will set future land uses across the Perth Peel Region. While no longer a ‘live’ document, the NRM Strategy is considered to still be a relevant reference document that provides detailed context and background on the South West Group’s NRM efforts to date. It also provided the foundation for the contracting of a NRM Facilitator to drive implementation of the Strategy.
