Goolugatup Heathcote and Lowerlands for Detailed Interpretation & Landscape Design

The City of Melville, in collaboration with community and stakeholders, has an ambitious plan to realise the potential of Goolugatup (formerly Heathcote) Lowerlands; a significant cultural and heritage place. This project aims to rejuvenate the environment, share important stories and encourage passive recreation. With a respectful approach, it will provide enormous benefits as a pathway to state-wide reconciliation and increased community association to the Goolugatup Lowerlands.

Located on Duncraig Road, Applecross, Western Australia, the Goolugatup Lowerlands is currently a low-key open passive recreational space next to the river. The vision is to retain this basic character, whilst improving amenity and expressing the site's significant cultural and natural heritage value through strong interpretation elements.

The current design has been developed in partnership with traditional owners' and this partnership is to continue throughout the design process. Through this project, the intention is to support and create opportunity for Aboriginal stewardship, skill and employment with a focus on rebuilding environmental and river health, particularly the wetlands element. This is a project that can contribute to place-based reconciliation.

The potential of this significant site is noted in the draft Western Australian Cultural Infrastructure Strategy and the City of Melville's Cultural Plan. This undeveloped site has many important stories to share with the community. Its Aboriginal history is currently not represented on site and its environmental and social potential is unrealised. We at the City of Melville, as caretakers of this important site, are seeking to work with key partners to help transform this potential into a high quality outcome.
