

Key insights

1. 99% of community members feel positively about the City as a place to live, and 81% are proud to live here.
2. The average quality of life rating is 7.9 out of 10, 0.8 points higher than the national average.
3. The City of Melville continues to be a high performing council.
 - The overall governance score is 61 out of 100; 9 points above the industry average.
 - Value for money from Council rates scored 52 points, down 5 points but still 10 points ahead of the industry average.
 - All 42 service areas tested were on par with or above the industry average.
 - The library is the City's highest performing service area, followed by playgrounds, parks and reserves.
4. Although performance continues to be good relative to other councils, performance ratings have declined across several service areas.
 - The biggest declines were in community safety, traffic management and public transport, and waste, conservation and environmental management. These service areas all declined by 6 to 7 performance index points over the past year.
5. The community is seeking more effective leadership with good engagement and a clear vision for the future.
 - Council's leadership scored 43 points, down from a high of 62 in 2016 and now 1 point behind the industry average.
 - 32% of community members agree the City of Melville has a good understanding of community needs, down 10% points from last year and 26% points behind the industry leader.
 - 31% of community members agree there is a clear vision, down 9% points over the past year and 19% points behind the leader.

6. The community would like the Council to prioritise six key areas:

7. Consider how the City of Melville can help to build community connections and belonging:
 - 53% of community members agree the area has strong community spirit, down from 69% in 2015, and now only 1% point above the industry average.
 - Over the past four years, community members feel their life has less purpose (down from 97% to 80% agree), and they feel less valued and appreciated by others (down from 89% to 74% agree).
 - Only 50% of respondents agree that people in their local community appreciate, respect and celebrate diversity. Agreement is lower among people who do not identify as male or female, and among younger adults. The multiculturalism performance score is 63 points, 2 points ahead of the industry average, but lower among people who mainly speak a language other than English (54 points) and First Nations peoples (51 points).
 - 56% of community members would like to get to know their neighbours better. Interest is highest among people who mainly speak a language other than English (70%), families with younger children (66%), and younger adults (63%).
 - 76% of community members have been actively involved with at least one club, group or association over the past 12 months. Involvement is highest among families with primary school aged children (85%) and seniors (85%). Participation is lowest among younger adults (64%) and families with children aged 0-4 years (69%).
 - 61% of community members have volunteered or donated for a social cause or philanthropic project; 26% supported a cause or project within the local area. Volunteering rates are lowest among families with children aged 0-4 years (43%).
8. While the City of Melville is considered a good place to raise a family (90% agree), there is a need to deliver better services and facilities for families and young people.
 - Parents with younger children report the lowest wellbeing scores for sleep and exercise.
 - The performance index score for youth services dropped from a high of 69 points in 2016 to 53 points this year.
 - Performance levels for youth services continue to be ahead of the industry average, but now trail the industry leader by 12 points.
9. The City is considered a good place to grow old. While 81% agree, this has fallen from 89% agree in 2019. The rating is slightly lower among seniors (78% agree).
 - The performance index score for seniors' services, facilities care has dropped from a high of 74 points in 2014 and 2016 to 64 points this year, however, performance continues to be well ahead of the industry average (+10 points).

Key insights

10. The City of Melville is well regarded for access to health and community services with a performance index score of 67 out of 100; just 1 point behind the industry leader.
 - 61% of respondents self-assessed their own general health as good or excellent, 9% points above the state average for WA.
 - Between 2020 and 2023, ratings improved for general and mental health.

11. Access to education, training and life-long learning is moderate at 58 performance index points, however, this is 9 points above average.
 - 59% of respondents had participated in an educational activity, such as short courses, workshops or seminars, in the past 12 months. Participation was much higher among 35-49 year olds (72%) and among people with post-graduate qualifications (75%). Participation levels were lowest among First Nations peoples (16%) and people with the highest level of education being high school (33%) or TAFE (46%).
 - Among people who are unemployed or seeking work, 19% do not think they have sufficient education and training to get a job. Ratings are higher among females, parents with teenagers, and people who have completed high school or TAFE as their highest qualification.
 - The library is well regarded with a performance index score of 78 out of 100, 8 points above industry average.

12. People who work in the City of Melville work longer hours than the national average. Among those who are employed, 28% reported that they regularly work over 50 hours per week. This compares to a national average of 13% who work more than 49 hours per week.

13. 81% of community members rate their personal financial situation as good, very good or excellent.
 - The financial situation is much better for homeowners (62 index points) than people who are renting (47 index points).
 - Self-reported financial wellbeing is highest in Attadale (73 points) and lowest in Bull Creek (52 points) and Willagee (53 points).
 - 5% of respondents spend more than they earn, 22% have just enough money to get by and 4% spend all left-over money. After household spending, 70% of respondents say they can generally save some money occasionally or regularly.

- Determine community priorities
- Benchmark performance



The Study

The City of Melville commissioned CATALYSE® to conduct an independent MARKYT® Community Scorecard.

CATALYSE® emailed scorecard to 32,352 randomly selected customers from the City of Melville’s databases. The City provided supporting promotions through its communication channels. The scorecard was open from 9 to 30 October 2023.



The direct email campaign achieved an open rate of 62% (n=20,359) and a 9% response rate (n=1,733).


Overall, **1,967 community members** took part in the study.











Quality of life dimensions


Respondents were invited to self-assess eight quality of life dimensions. A MARKYT® Wellbeing Index was calculated to track and benchmark results. The Index Score is a single measure that takes all respondent ratings into account. It is a zero-based score expressed out of 100, where 0 is poor and 100 is excellent.

Overall, community wellbeing has improved over the past three years. However, it should be noted that wellbeing dimensions were last measured in 2020 at the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic. The only dimension in decline is social relationships.

The lowest rated quality of life dimension was sleep, followed by exercise. As shown in the detailed analysis to follow, sleep and exercise ratings were lowest among parents with younger children and people with disability.











Community Action Plans

Top priorities

Community driven actions

- Improve the Community Safety Service (CSS):
 - Provide more patrols, especially at night and in known hotspots.
 - Provide CSS Officers with more powers so they can be more proactive and effective.
- Advocate for a greater police presence.
- Provide more CCTV and lighting in streets, parks, shopping centres, train stations and other hotspots.
- Provide incentives or rebates for residents to install security measures in their homes.
- Better support and promotion of community safety programs, such as Neighbourhood Watch.
- Educate and engage with the community about safety issues.

Community Voices

“Visible security patrolling at hot spot places“

““Effective security patrols that actually address issues rather than driving past.”

“Security people need more power to apprehend when circumstances call for it as the crimes are well aware that they are toothless tigers“

“Maybe more collaboration with WAPOL to patrol higher crime rate areas? Be proactive rather than reactive. Instead of increasing patrols just in the suburb currently complaining about a rise in reported crime, increase patrols everywhere.”

“It would be nice to see a policeman on the street, or a car patrolling the area. I am sure the Council could ask the police for a presence to stop the burglaries in the area.”

“Security cameras to deter offenders, more security officers at public venues ie shopping centres.”

“Better lighting & more cameras in crime hotspots especially near shops where crime happens more & at traffic lights where people cleaning windows become violent.”

“Better lighting on streets, more mobile CCTV to help CSS monitor entry points typically between 1:30am - 4:30am where a lot of the break-ins happen, more CCS mobile patrol during this time.”

*“Discounted access to home security items, doors, cameras etc.
Community classes on cybersecurity.”*

“Neighbourhood Watch establishment, visibility of the police, patrols etc.”

“With the growing ‘baby boomer’ age group population, more emphasis is required on providing support to volunteer community groups like the Neighbourhood Watch, which is a successful worldwide brand name for crime prevention.”

“Crime prevention through direct addressing of known problems - engaging with the locals to address direct issues.”

“Make marketing material that notes the connection between community programs being funded and impact on crime rates. Show people how investing in community, having a connected and engaged community (and not just people who sit at home scared to go out watching the American news) actually makes them safer.”

Community driven actions

- Upgrade Len Shearer playing fields and facilities.
- Upgrade or provide new facilities at sporting grounds, including better parking, clubrooms, change rooms and toilets (separate for males and females).
 - Prioritise the refurbishment and development of facilities at Troy Park.
 - Other specific mentions include Tompkins Park, Winnicott Reserve, Karoonda Reserve and netball courts, John Connell reserve, Alan Edwards Reserve, Tingara Netball Club, and Morris Buzacott Reserve.
- Upgrade facilities at LeisureFit Booragoon and Melville.
- Provide more swimming pool facilities throughout the City - outdoor, indoor, 50m, heated options.
- Ensure all Council facilities are inclusive and accessible for all ages, abilities and incomes.

Community Voices

"Continued refresh of facilities. New (or at least not run down) facilities equate to high usage (ie Karoonda netball courts)."

"Updated or new ablution blocks for women and girls at netball courts, hockey grounds, sport grounds, where men are mainly the majority."

"Improvement of Troy Park clubrooms and general area including playground. Original master plan without second football field. This has been forgotten over the last 2 years after considerable positive feedback from Melville City residents."

"Upgrade of Troy Park to a modern facility that incorporates a cafe or restaurant as well as lighting facilities for nighttime sport."

"Len Shearer facility remain an embarrassment to Melville City. They are so old and outdated and the council refuse to let the club leverage funds from potential sponsors of the grounds by restricting signage allowed. Many other sports facilities in the city have had upgrades. Len Shearer has had none event though it has the largest football club membership in WA"

"The pool at Wheatley Drive [has] closed and the nearest pool is Melville Aquatic Centre or Riverton - not a quick drive! I would like to see a pool available in the Leeming Rec Centre please. There used to be one but was removed. Bad decision!"

"For a city of this size there should be more than one public swimming pool. The closure of the pool at Booragoon leaves so many users without any viable option within a reasonable distance. The City shut down pools, they should build at least one more."

"I hope to see a fully refurbished or new Melville aquatic centre because I'd rather go to the Cockburn aquatic centre instead of the current Melville's."

"Fixing sagging roof at Strength for Life facility at Melville Rec Centre - it's a health and safety issue!"

"The leisure centres are quite outdated and need to be upgraded. The Booragoon pool is being upgraded but the gym and group fitness areas are quite poor as well, especially the change room and toilet situation. It doesn't promote going to the gym and changing before/after work."

"I love the number of sport and recreation facilities, which are great for able-bodied people, but would like to see recreation programs there that include all abilities, ages and incomes."

"Better and cheaper access for ratepayers - free for ratepayers. Cheaper access to scheduled programs for elderly, like yoga, and more offered than 1-2x per week."

Community driven actions

- Improve access to seniors' services and activities with improved footpaths, seating, more parking and community transport services.
- Provide a dedicated community centre for seniors to meet and socialise.
- Provide a range of activities and events to keep seniors active and connected in their community. Suggestions include education programs, outdoor exercise groups and equipment, arts and crafts and a men's shed.
- Subsidise the costs of activities and memberships at Council facilities for seniors.
- Advertise the range of services and activities available for seniors more widely.
- Provide improved access to affordable accommodation options for downsizing seniors.
- Support seniors living independently at home with better access to home-care services.

Community Voices

"Adequate ACROD parking, seniors parking bays for the many who are frail but don't qualify for ACROD, attention to paths, paving and access, assistance and education with continually changing technologies."

"Better street lighting and better maintained footpaths."

"More transport options for seniors that are free. Shopping, hospital and health appointments are difficult for people to get to if they don't have family support."

"An active and dynamic Senior Citizens Centre as they have in Rockingham. Seniors of today ask for more than indoor bowls, bingo etc."

"A community centre in Melville specifically for seniors with lots more activities, workshops and community engagement. Activities for seniors. Melville Council should showcase a place like this. It should be run by the council and not put in private hands or management."

"Have programs, workshops, crafts, physical fitness, social events, info sessions, home improvement events, gardening, make friends, be involved together events, clubs etc for 65 to 75 age group."

"Give seniors a reduced rate at the swimming pool. \$6.60 per swim mounts up if your doctor has recommended swimming three times or more a week!"

"Discount cards for seniors aged 60 and above for local community services in the Melville Council. Gyms, health spas are too expensive for retirees."

"What I would like to see is a newsletter or some other means of communication to all seniors in the Melville community giving specific notices as what is available to us seniors."

"Information regarding what services and help is available to allow seniors to stay in their homes. Alternative accommodation on one level not high rise in the surrounding areas on small blocks with easy access."

"Areas with smaller, less expensive housing with some garden, so that seniors can move out of large family homes without compromising on amenities."

"I'd like to see more emphasis on providing suitable homes in which seniors would like to reside in the area in which they often have spent many years as active participants in the community."

"Provide more assistance for access to services older residents find harder to perform, ie. gardening, household duties, shopping, transport, etc. which may enable them to stay in their own home longer."

Community driven actions

- Encourage households to adopt sustainable practices with education, financial incentives, rebates etc.
- Promote recycling with education and by providing more recycling bins and drop-off points for soft plastics, batteries, e-waste, light bulbs, fluorocarbons, etc.
- Encourage greater adoption of renewable energy technology including solar panels, community batteries and electric vehicles.
- Lead by example – adopt sustainable practices in Council operations such as solar panels on buildings, and an electric vehicle fleet.
- Impose stricter sustainability requirements on new developments e.g. water wise, solar panels, no dark roofs, sustainable building materials.
- Retain trees and green space in new developments and plant more trees to increase shade canopy and reduce urban heat.
- Discourage reliance on petrol-fuelled cars with more EV charging stations and improved public transport and active transport options.

Community Voices

“Assistance for households for solar, water saving etc.”

“Rebate on rates for those looking at sustainable homes.”

“More environmental awareness campaigns raising issue of climate change and importance of protecting and growing trees, using public transport, protecting waterways and our native environment.”

“Better education on recyclables and more access to drop off fluorocarbons and e-waste.”

“We need to promote and educate people on how to recycle properly. I find many people are not interested/ don't care. Maybe have recycling drives, more 'specific item' recycling (like the bottle top hill but make it MORE accessible).”

“Encourage and facilitate renewable energy hubs, solar panels hub batteries etc.”

“Council facilities to upgrade to large solar and battery storage systems. Council car fleet to transition to electric once prices drop. Continue street verge tree planting.”

“Move to hybrid powered rubbish and vehicle fleet. Encouragement of community solar batteries in small areas not major suburb locations”

“House planning laws need to be changed to enforce sustainable housing design (solar passive) and ensure they don't impact design of neighbours when building (eg shading northern aspect windows and solar panels etc)”

“Protection of tree canopy, enhancing biodiversity of public spaces, encouraging trees in backyards, regulations around footprint of new houses (carbon footprint, spatial footprint), not approving in environmentally sustainable house design, public education. Incentives to build environmentally sound development.”

“...protecting native trees, planting more trees, and preventing whole-sale destruction of blocks for development.”

“Major reduction of car use. Short trip public transport - buses trams to access local shops, school runs etc”

“Promote healthy active transport over driving by providing better facilities, footpaths, pedestrian crossings, etc.”

Community driven actions

- Grow the urban canopy by planting more trees and preserving existing, mature trees.
- Plant larger, more mature trees to increase their chance of survival.
- Plant more native and waterwise plants in parks and verges.
- Encourage alternatives to grass on verges, and consider banning fake grass.
- Improve verge maintenance - trimming trees, mowing and slashing more regularly.
- Encourage property owners to maintain their properties and verges with education programs and incentives.
- Clean-up rubbish in median strips and verges.
- Provide underground power.
- Repair broken and uneven footpaths.

Community Voices

"There aren't a lot of trees along the footpaths. So having some shade would encourage more people to exercise/make kids walking home from school more comfortable."

"More trees planted to reduce suburb temperatures and help climate change."

"Tree canopy policy which restrict / control removal of trees for the purpose of commercial and residential development."

"Adopt and police a policy to ensure all owners and tenants of private properties maintain their verges to a reasonable standard."

"... encourage local property owners to create individual gardens on street verges. However, I believe artificial grass should be banned on council owned verges. I would like Melville to encourage more tree planting especially trees that attract native birds like the Carnaby cockatoo."

"An increased awareness of planting only natives/waterwise plants."

"Ban the use of plastic "grass" and encourage homeowners to plant native bushes instead."

"Provide grants to support the conversion of verges from grass to native vegetation."

"The median strips and verges on Canning Hwy between Norma Road and Stock Road are very neglected. This patch of road is the entrance to Attadale and Bicton. This sets a horrible first impression of the suburbs and lowers property values. It also creates a very dry and hot ecosystem in the area during summer. Verge planting and median strip beautification is long overdue."

"Brentwood shops needs a spruce up with plants and trees."

"Beautify Moolyean Rd into the Brentwood shopping area from Leach Hwy. Make coming into the little suburb inviting!!!"

"All areas to have underground power. I have been waiting for 15 years and the longer the delay the higher the eventual cost to install."

Community driven actions

- The community is deeply concerned about the speed and scale of high-rise development and subdivisions, and the lack of planning to address adverse impacts including traffic, parking, overshadowing, destruction of the urban tree canopy, and lack of green spaces.
- Residents want genuine community engagement to create a shared vision and strategic plan to ensure responsible growth and development in future, and remedies for current issues.
- Many accept that some infill is needed, and for some people infill and high-rise development is preferred to provide improved access to affordable and green housing choices, but it must be done in a responsible, fair and sustainable way to preserve and enhance the area's character and lifestyle.

Community Voices

"Complete lack of vision in relation to allowing enormous developments without adequate access/traffic solutions and detrimental to adjoining properties/areas."

"A coordinated approach with a vision for the suburb keeping its character. Not like Applecross where high rise wrecks the ambiance of the area!"

"More consideration and management of the consequences of urban infill."

"The lack of a strategic plan to facilitate acceptable forms of urban infill is destroying Melville. There needs to be a genuine discussion with the city communities, to develop an acceptable response to growth management that is supported by clear stated commitments to improving the public realm to support such growth. It is calamitous to see how detached urban intensification continues to be with the services and facilities needed to support liveability of much more denser environments."

"Modernise planning to reflect community needs."

"More community involvement and consultation with experts in future growth to balance environment, transport, open spaces with increase in population."

"Be proactive in dealings with State Planning to ensure the impacts of growth and development are more considered. Better communication of the visions and goals, and how they impact or benefit local residents is necessary."

"Have a cap on apartment development heights and densities to avoid overshadowing, privacy issues and traffic congestion."

"Growth and development is necessary, but not if we simply create more congestion issues in the process. Ingress and egress of traffic needs to accompany every major development and shouldn't cause greater issues for residents in the process."

"Adopt the principle of higher density residential development around public transport hubs to slow down the rate of urban expansion in Perth."

"Denser housing, less car-dependent living, greener city."













among people who are unemployed or seeking work


If unemployed or seeking new work, do you feel you have sufficient education and training to get a job?




